MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL AND JOINING FOR 2012

The club has set out below the basic operation for 2012's membership information which has resulted in membership fees being brought more in line with the rest of the regions as follows:

1. Joining fees are R500 for the Year for New Members.
2. Social Porsche Club Annual Subscriptions are R850 for the year.
3. Subscriptions are due on 1 January 2012.
4. If you join after 30 June 75% of the Annual Subscription is applicable.

Social Subscriptions:

1. The Annual Subscription will allow you access to all National Social Events the Porsche Club runs, which include; Breakfast Runs, the Annual Concours, the Dinner Dance Awards evening, the AGM, Weekends Away, the Annual Parade and a Factory Visit is planned for this year. In addition to this access to the club's facilities, office and communication via email and sms is assured, a Joining Gift Pack and both an E-zine as well as three/four copies of our National Magazine.
2. Where possible invitations to additional special events such as Social Evenings, Noggins and Race Events will be extended to club members.
3. Events that are not sponsored or only partially sponsored may result in an additional participation cost and will be communicated to members before the event with relevant participation details.

Other Activities:

1. In order to improve member's skills in driving our fantastic cars, we will also be implementing a Driver Training Program (DTP) this year under our associated organization TIPRA. On the membership form you will see a block for you to mark if you have an interest in this and TIPRA will contact you.

2. The DTP will consist of attendance at one of four skidpans, and attendance at both track day events (Zwartkops and Kyalami). The track events will not be competitive or timed and full time instruction will be available. The costs of this are being finalized at present.
3. Please note that experienced drivers can also attend the DTP by for the sake of improving their driving skills. Under these conditions instruction will not be required and the cost will be correspondingly reduced.
4. We also continue to run the competitive Time Trial series through TIPRA, which comprises 8 events at various tracks during the year. The cost of this will be placed on record as soon as the track bookings have been confirmed.
5. Lastly TIPRA will run various race series during the coming year as it did last year. This includes a GT4 class-racing category for new technology cars called **GT Challenge**, a new category for older technology cars (1995 and older) called **GT Classic** and the current **Handicap Challenge** series.

Payment Options:

The annual subscription for the Porsche Club of SA – Central is an annual payment as is the various annual TIPRA subscriptions.

Participation in events can be paid - either on an ad hoc basis - or as an option - annually at a discounted rate. These amounts will be publicized shortly.
